NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all yacht clubs in good standing with Sail Canada and be an Ontario based club.

3.2 Crew Requirements:

- a) Minimum total of 5 crew and a maximum of 6 crew (no weight limits).
- b) Each participating Club shall ensure that all crew are members in good standing of the club in the year prior to the event
- c) Crew must include at least one member of the club's own youth sailing program and be 18 years of age or younger as of September 1, 2017. If the club does not have its own youth sailing program, a written request shall be submitted to the organizing authority for a youth sailor from an alternate club. The request must include the name of the youth and the club in which the youth participates.

3.3 Eligible teams may enter by completing the on-line registration by Sept.8th, 2017. Late registrations will be given consideration by the OA.

3.4 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: A maximum of 10 teams will be invited to participate.

3.5 National One Design Sailing Academy, as the Organizing Authority may refuse entry to anyone for whatever reasons at their sole discretion.

4 BOATS

4.1 The event will be sailed in Flying Tiger 7.5s provided by National One Design Sailing Academy.

4.2 Boats will be provided for all competitors, who shall not modify them or cause them to be modified in any way except that

- (a) a compass may be tied or taped to the hull or spars, the compass may not be capable of sending or receiving any data of any kind and shall show boat's heading only.
- (b) wind indicators, including yarn or thread, may be tied or taped anywhere on the boat;
- (c) hull, deck and rudder may be cleaned, but only with water;

(d) adhesive tape may be used anywhere above the gunwale.

- 4.3** All equipment provided with the boat for sailing purposes shall be in the boat while afloat.
- 4.4** The penalty for not complying with one of the above instructions will be disqualification from all races sailed in which the instruction was broken.
- 4.5** Competitors shall report any damage or loss of equipment, however slight, to the organizing authority's representative immediately after securing the boat ashore. The penalty for breaking this instruction, unless the protest committee is satisfied that the competitor made a determined effort to comply, will be disqualification from the race most recently sailed.
- 4.6** Boat allocations will be decided by a drawing of boat numbers at Registration.

5 FEES

- 5.1** Required registration fee is \$500.00 + HST.
- 5.2** Teams must provide a \$1,500.00 refundable damage deposit at registration. An outline of damage costs will be provided at the event.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1** Team registration will be between 1300 and 1800 hours on Friday, September 16 and 0900 and 0930 on Saturday, September 17.
- 6.2** Dates of racing:

- 6.3** 8 races are scheduled with a maximum of 5 per day.
- 6.4** Boats will be available for open practice between 1300 and 1900 hours on Friday September 15.
- 6.5** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1100 hours on Saturday, September 16 and 1030 hours on Sunday, September 17.
- 6.6** No warning signal will be made after 1530 hours on Sunday, September 17.
- 6.7** The mandatory competitor meeting is scheduled for 0930 hours on Saturday, September 16 immediately in front of the boats.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available to the competitors on the 16th September at registration.

8 VENUE

All racing will take place on Lake Ontario off Bronte Harbour, course location will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

9 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the harbour.

10 PRIZES

10.1 Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.

10.2 The 1D Sailing Cup will be awarded to the first place team.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Sail Canada prescription rule 4, Decision to Race. National One Design Sailing Academy may, at their sole discretion, cancel racing at any given time should they so decide. Neither One Design Sailing Academy nor organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
